



Build Up and Breakdown

Set up is on Wednesday 26th November 2025 up until 10pm. Contracted stand builders have priority access from 8:30am and exhibitors from 11:00am.

Forklift Availability

Should you require the services of a forklift, please let us know and this can be arranged for an additional fee. It may be possible for several traders to share the fee. If you need to arrange any deliveries to the event centre, please let Kate Dickinson (kate@bfrepa.co.uk) know especially if it is going to be before set up day.

Breakdown can take place from 4:30pm on Thursday 27th November up until 10pm. Any fees incurred by BFREPA due to stand holders not breaking down their trade stand by the deadline time, may be passed onto the exhibitor.

Should exhibitors require to arrange pick up following the event, please let Kate Dickinson (kate@bfrepa.co.uk) know especially if it is going to be after the event.

For your safety, and the safety of others, the following guidelines must be adhered to during these times:

- No persons under the age of 16 are permitted in the exhibition halls during these periods
- 2 No vehicles will be allowed to load / unload or enter / exit the venue until authorised by a member of the venue security team



- 3 No large items i.e., pop-up stands or trolleys may be taken through any of the main public entrances. All equipment must exit the building via the roller doors at the rear and side of the halls
- 4 Stands must not be broken down until all public are clear from the hall
- 5 Roller doors at the side and rear of the halls will not be opened until the venue security team & organisers are happy that the area is clear of general public, and the Event Manager gives approval to do so.

6 All staff to wear hi-vis during set up and break down.

Parking

Deliveries

No deliveries will be accepted by Telford International Centre without prior agreement. If you need to arrange for a delivery or collection to be made for your stand, please note deliveries / collections will only be accepted during normal working hours 09:00 - 17:00 Monday to Friday.



Please contact kate@bfrepa.co.uk or 03301 744755 (Option 1) to arrange a delivery/collection and obtain the relevant label. All deliveries should be clearly labelled with the delivery labels.

Please note should a delivery arrives outside of tenancy hours; the delivery may get turned away and any collection without collection labels will be disposed of. BFREPA cannot accept any responsibility for incorrect labelling or missing goods.

Provision of Alcoholic and Non-Alcoholic Drinks on Stand

Exhibitors are permitted to serve alcoholic refreshments or other non-alcoholic drinks from their stand to visitors at the National Free Range Egg Show. A corkage fee may be applicable. Please refer to the Telford International Centre portal exhibiter stand services where this can be booked.

Exhibitor Badges

All exhibitor staff will need to wear day delegate badges during the event and must wear hi-vis on build day on 26 November 2025 and during breakdown. Tickets and badges are non-transferrable. Please contact Kate@bfrepa.co.uk if you wish to amend a day delegate's details.

Insurance

The Exhibitor must insure for their legal liability, including:

- Employers Liability of no less than 5 million pounds



A copy of the Public Liability Insurance certificate must be held on your stand throughout the duration of the event and must be provided upon request from the event organisers or the enforcing authorities.

Rigging, Drop Wires & Banners

All rigging must be ordered through Stagecraft and the web portal for trade stand services

Risk Assessment & Method StatementFire Safety - Stand Construction

There are strict regulations governing the materials, which may be used in the construction of stands and in the demonstration of products. All materials must comply with British Standard Numbers BS476 and BS5570 and/or BS3120. Exhibitors should ensure that their Contractor are made aware of these requirements.

The Organisers / Venue / Local Authority reserve the right to remove any items which do not meet statutory requirements or which in their view, constitute a hazard. Failure to comply with this requirement could lead to stand closure.

Method Statements (larger stands only)

For larger Clear Floor Space and stands a Method Statement detailing how the stand will be built and operate is required.

The deadline for returning your Method Statement is 27 October 2025.


We strongly recommend that any small or attractive items be kept under constant supervision.

- 1 A Health & Safety Risk Assessment form is enclosed with this pack and must be completed and returned to Kate Dickinson, BFREPA Events Manager (kate@bfrepa.co.uk) prior to the event. The following items are classified as items of special risk and should be included in your risk assessment:

 - Flagpoles
 - Animals
 - BBQ, garden pools and water features
 - Compressed gas

- Laser products and displays
- Naked flames (note candles are not permitted within the venue)
- Pyrotechnics
- · Radioactive substances
- Smoke machines
- Strobe lighting
- · Vehicle displays
- Welding and hot works
- Working displays and machinery structures over 4m in height
- Children under 16 years of age

2 It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to hold the necessary Public Liability Insurance cover for third party risks and to ensure all their staff and contractors work in accordance with the relevant Health & Safety legislations.

The Exhibitor's public liability insurance must also include all and any risks including personal injury with a recommended minimum of £5 million insurance cover.

3 BFREPA has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present, for those measures to be effective, please take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of BFREPA's Officials, Stewards, and event centre staff.

Dan Walker is the lead anchor on Channel 5's re-launched flagship news bulletin, 5 News. Since joining Channel 5, Dan has also presented numerous peak time shows for the channel, including Vanished – Britain's Hunt for Missing People and the hugely popular Dan & Helen's Pennine Adventure, which he hosts alongside Helen Skelton.

A standout achievement in Dan's career was when he was asked by Comic Relief to help raise funds by climbing Kilimanjaro with a number of other famous faces. The resulting documentary for BBC1, Return to Kili, followed the team's fund-raising journey.

His reputation as a sensitive and thoughtful interviewer lead to him being asked to present A Royal Team Talk: Tackling Mental Health for BBC1 with HRH The Duke of Cambridge.

Together with five A-list footballers, including Gareth Southgate and Peter Crouch, they gathered together for an extraordinary and honest conversation about men's mental health. The programme was incredibly well received and subsequently went on to be nominated for several awards. Dan has also presented The One Show and Songs of Praise.

As an author, Dan has written a number of books, including Standing on the Shoulders: Incredible Heroes and How They Inspire Us, a sequel to the bestselling Remarkable People. His other books also include Dan Walker's Thronkersaurus: Football's Finest Tales, and Magic, Mud & Maradona.

When not working, Dan loves nothing more than playing golf, and for the last 5 years Dan has organised his own charity golf tournament, The Walker Cup (not that one), raising over £250,000 for The Children's Hospital Charity. Dan is proud to live in
