A small, collaborative group of forward thinking participants focused on sharing ideas, learning from each other and improving both individual businesses, farm management (ground level), and and the wider sector.



Open to experienced producers, employees, family business members, farm staff and those directly involved with the egg industry with at least three years' experience in free range egg production or pullet rearing.



A 12 month development programme for ambitious free range egg producers, farm staff, trade and allied industry professionals, designed to build knowledge, leadership and industry understanding.



Hands on visits across the entire egg supply chain, from hatchery and rearing through to depletion and beyond, including packing, retail, processing and policy engagement. The programme includes four structured visits across the 12 months, each typically involving two full days of activity and overnight stays, alongside attendance at the BFREPA Conference and Awards.



Supported by BFREPA and ForFarmers UK, the academy aims to develop the next generation of industry leaders while creating valuable networking, learning and future board level opportunities.
